# SCHOOL OF AUDIOLOGY & SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY

Audiology and Speech Language Pathology is an upcoming field in allied health sciences. There is a dearth of Speech Language Pathologists and Audiologists in India as very few colleges provide educational facilities in this field. Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) decided to fulfill this long-standing deficiency in Maharashtra by starting a School of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (SASLP) in the educational capital, the city of Pune under the medical faculty in August 2006. SASLP is located at the Dhankawadi Campus of Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University).

#### ABOUT AUDIOLOGY AND SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY

Audiology is a branch of science that deals with hearing and hearing related disorders. Students of Audiology are educated regarding the anatomy and physiology of the normal and abnormal auditory system. They are trained in identification and differential diagnosis of auditory disorders. These include disorders of the middle ear, inner ear, auditory nerve and the central auditory nervous system. With training, students develop expertise in audiological rehabilitation, which includes recommendation of amplification devices including hearing aids and cochlear implants. They also learn about assessment and management of individuals with tinnitus, vestibular disorders and auditory processing disorders.

Speech and Language Pathology deals with the normal and abnormal aspects of voice, speech, language and swallowing. Students of Speech Language Pathology are trained in diagnosis, differential diagnosis and management of speech and language disorders, which includes voice disorders, speech sound disorder, stuttering, speech and language problems associated with hearing impairment, intellectual disability, cerebral palsy, cleft palate, autism spectrum disorders, oral and laryngeal cancers, stroke/ paralysis, and learning disorders.

# ACTIVITIES OF THE SCHOOL OF AUDIOLOGY AND SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY

#### **ACADEMIC PROGRAMS**

The college conducts an undergraduate program, Bachelors in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (B.ASLP), a four years course; two post graduate programs - Masters of Science (Audiology) and Master of Science (Speech Language Pathology) and two doctoral programs - Ph.D. (Audiology) and Ph.D. (Speech Language Pathology).

#### The highlights of the academic program are as follows:

- The courses are affiliated to Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) and are recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI).
- Infrastructure at the college includes classrooms and seminar halls with facility for audiovisual presentation (LCD projectors) which is upgraded regularly.
- The teaching program is conducted by qualified and experienced faculty with an equal focus on theory, practicals, clinics and research.
- Guest lectures by experts in the field are arranged regularly to broaden the horizons and promote exchange of information.
- The college has a well-stocked library with books and scientific journals. New books and journals are added regularly.
- The staff of the college carry out orientation programs for allied professionals, which include pediatricians, general practitioners, teachers of the normal schools and special schools for children with communication disorders.
- Workshops/ Seminars/ Symposia are conducted to orient the students on recent advances in the field and to update the knowledge of the professionals in the field.
- Academic activities of the college include clinical case conferences and journal clubs to orient the students to the basics of research.
- Students present scientific papers at conferences under the guidance of the faculty.
- Research publications and projects.

#### CLINICAL SERVICES AVAILABLE AT THE COLLEGE

The college has state of the art facilities for the evaluation and rehabilitation of individuals with speech, language and hearing disorders. Besides the college, these services are offered at the Department of ENT and the Department of Pediatrics of the Bharati Hospital Bedside assessments and management is carried out in wards of Bharati Hospital for individuals with neurogenic speech & language disorders and vestibular disorders. Camps are conducted at schools for children with communication disorders and in rural areas. School screening programs are conducted to identify children with speech, language, literacy and hearing problems.

#### **AUDIOLOGY**

Assessment and differential diagnosis of auditory disorders, which includes facilities such as pure-tone audiometry, speech audiometry, glycerol test, immitance evaluation, recording of Auditory Evoked Potentials (ABR/ BERA, MLR, LLR, MMN, P300), Auditory Steady State Response (ASSR) and Otoacoustic Emissions (OAE), bedside audio vestibular screening and newborn hearing screening.

- Selection of hearing aids and other assistive listening devices using objective evaluation tools like Long Latency Responses (LLR) and insertion gain.
- Rehabilitation/ Habilitation of individuals with hearing impairment.
- Assessment and management of individuals with auditory processing disorders.
- School screening for hearing and Central Auditory Processing Disorders (CAPD)
- Selection of candidates for cochlear implants and post cochlear implant rehabilitation.
- Assessment and management of individuals with tinnitus and hyperacusis.
- Assessment of individuals with vertigo (vestibulocochlear disorder).
- Intraoperative monitoring of Cochlear Implant.
- Assessment and differential diagnosis of vestibular disorders which includes facilities such as Video head impulse test.

#### SPECIALITY CLINICS IN SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY

The College runs seven specialty clinics to cater specifically to the needs of certain client population.



With a Bachelor's degree in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (B.ASLP), professionals are certified to practice Audiology and Speech and language pathology in various clinical and academic set ups.

Masters of Science (Audiology) and Masters of Science (Speech Language Pathology) provides an in depth theoretical knowledge, disorders specific evidence based clinical training for the following:

### PROCEDURE AND RULES FOR ADMISSION

Separate computer center based entrance tests will be conducted for MSc. (Audiology) which will be referred as **BV-MSc. AUDIO** and MSc. (Speech Language Pathology) which will be referred as **BV-MSc. SPEECH-23**.

#### 1. GENERAL

The information and rules given here in are applicable for admissions to the first year of two years full time post graduate degree programme of Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Pune: [Masters of Science (Audiology) & Masters of Science (Speech Language Pathology)]. The seats will be filled on merit, based on their performance in "BV-MSc. SPEECH-23 / BV-MSc. AUDIO-23 Computer center Based Entrance Test", conducted by Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University).

Ten percent (10%) supernumerary seats of over and above the sanctioned intake are reserved for NRI/ Foreign quota, candidates from Andaman & Nicobar, Lakshwadeep & Northeast and Jammu & Kashmir. Candidates desirous of getting admission under these Categories will have to apply separately on a prescribed application form. The application form will be available at the office of **The Registrar**, **Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University)**, **Bharati Vidyapeeth Bhavan**, **L.B.S. Marg**, **Pune-30**. The form fee for this category is **Rs.** 1000/- (non refundable). The last date for submission of form to this category at the above mentioned address is 30th June 2023.

Only those candidates who would satisfy all the eligibility requirements as mentioned above will be considered eligible to appear in the computer center based entrance test and for admission to the programme.

All the candidates seeking admissions will have to appear for computer center based entrance tests **BV-MSc. SPEECH-23** / **BV-MSc. AUDIO-23**. conducted by Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Pune for Master of Science (Audiology) and Master of Science (Speech Language Pathology) respectively. All candidates will have to apply online & fill the prescribed online application form at the website: www.bvuniversity.edu.in.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility requirements for admission to First year Masters of Science (Audiology) and Masters of Science (Speech Language Pathology) through computer center based entrance tests- BV-MSc. SPEECH-23 / BV-MSc. AUDIO-23 respectively are as follows:

2.1 Candidates with B.ASLP or B.Sc. (Speech & Hearing) degree of any recognized University by the Rehabilitation Council of India with a minimum of 55% of aggregate marks are eligible for the admission to the programme.

Only those candidates who satisfy or are likely to satisfy the relevant eligibility requirements for admission to the course will be considered eligible to appear for the computer center based entrance test and subsequently for admission to the programme.

#### 3. BASIS OF SELECTION FOR ADMISSION

3.1 A Candidate desirous of seeking admission to First Year Master of Science (Audiology) or Master of Science (Speech Language Pathology) program should fulfill the minimum eligibility condition as stated in **point no. 2** above. The final admission will be offered based solely on the merit obtained at the All India Computer center

- Based Entrance Tests "BV-MSc. SPEECH-23 / BV-MSc. AUDIO-23" conducted by Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Pune for the respective programmes.
- 3.2 He/ She must have appeared for the Computer center Based Entrance Tests "BV-MSc. SPEECH-23 / BV-MSc. AUDIO-23" Test, conducted by Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Pune at the designated centre.
- 3.3 The Candidate shall be offered admission on the basis of his/ her rank in the final merit list and availability of the seats for a particular program at a Institute of the candidate's choice at the time of counseling and admission in the concerned Institute. Mere appearance in the Computer center Based Entrance Tests and inclusion of name in the merit list does not confer any automatic rights to secure admission to the program offered by the Institute. The selection and admission to the program is subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria.
- 3.4 Admissions to MSc. (Audiology) will be as per merit obtained in **BV-MSc. AUDIO-23** while admissions to MSc (Speech Language Pathology) will be as per merit obtained in **MSc. SPEECH-23**.
- 3.5 In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the **BV-MSc. SPEECH-23 / BV-MSc. AUDIO-23** the inter-se-merit of such candidates shall be determined in order of preference as under:
  - 3.5.1 Candidate obtaining higher aggregate marks in B.ASLP If equal,
  - 3.5.2 Candidate obtaining higher marks in T.Y.B.ASLP/Aggregate of marks of Semester V and VI If equal,
  - 3.5.3 Candidate with longer work experience. If equal,
  - 3.5.4 Candidate obtaining higher marks in the 12th standard qualifying examination (such a tie will be settled at the time of counseling),
  - 3.5.5 In case of a tie at this level, computerized random selection of candidate will be carried out.

#### 4. NATURE OF COMPUTER BASED ONLINE ENTRANCE TEST "BV-MSc. SPEECH-23 / BV-MSc. AUDIO-23"

All candidates desirous of taking admission for First Year Master of Science (Audiology) / Master of Science (Speech Language Pathology) post graduate programme must appear for "BV-MSc. SPEECH-23 / BV-MSc. AUDIO-23" respectively"

4.1 The Computer center Based Entrance Tests "BV-MSc. SPEECH-23 / BV-MSc. AUDIO-23" for admission to First Year Master of Science (Audiology) / Master of Science (Speech Language Pathology) program will consist of a total of 50 marks and will be of 60 minutes duration.

The "BV-MSc. SPEECH-23 / BV-MSc. AUDIO-23" will be separate Computer center Based Entrance Tests consisting of separate question papers, set in English and will contain 50 multiple choice objective-type questions in respective subjects. The questions will be set on the syllabus of Audiology/ Speech language pathology subjects respectively of B.ASLP (2017) course as per RCI. Each of the 50 multiple choice questions will have four alternatives, with only one correct or most appropriate answer. One mark will be awarded for each correct answer. There is no negative marking.

Details regarding general instructions, terms and conditions of the computer center based entrance test mode, syllabus & schedule, entrance test centers, application procedure, Instructions regarding center based entrance test etc., are available on website. Please visit www.bvuniversity.edu.in for more details.

#### 5. ENTRANCE TEST FEE:

- 5.1 Entrance test fee: Rs 1500/-(Non Refundable) for MSc. (Audiology)-2023 / MSc. (Speech Language Pathology)-2023
- 5.2 The computer center based entrance test fee shall be paid through payment gateway using internet banking mode or through debit/credit card/UPI. Service charges and other taxes for transaction as applicable by bank has to be paid by the applicant.
- 5.3 The computer center based entrance test fee, once paid, will not be refunded under any circumstances. Candidates who remain absent for the computer center based entrance test will forfeit their computer center based entrance test fee.

#### 6. DECLARATION OF RESULT:

Separate merit list of "BV-MSc. SPEECH-23 / BV-MSc. AUDIO-23" (Based on 50 marks), will be notified at the website Please visit www.bvuniversity.edu.in for more details. Separate merit list will be prepared for regular category and Foreign/NRI/PIO/OCI/Institutional Quota Merit Category.

It is not possible to send individual invitation for counselling to the candidates. It shall be the responsibility of the individual candidate to see their own merit number and appear for the counselling at the centre of his/her choice as per schedule will be notified at the website.

#### 7. COUNSELLING AND SPOT ADMISSIONS:

7.1 The schedule and venue of counselling and on the spot admission session will be notified at the website. Please visit www.bvuniversity.edu.in for more details.

# FAILURE TO REPORT FOR COUNSELLING ON THE SCHEDULED DATE AND TIME WILL RESULT IN INSTANTANEOUS CANCELLATION OF A CLAIM OF THE CANDIDATE TO THE SEAT.

The candidate must note that appearance for the computer center based entrance test and inclusion of name in the merit list does not necessarily mean that he/she will get admission to the institute & programme. The admission will depend upon the availability of seats to the particular programme and institute at the time of his/her counselling.

It shall be candidates responsibility to see the result computer center based entrance test and confirm their merit no. The candidate should remain present for counselling as per the schedule **notified at the website**..

Individual counselling letters are not going to be sent. The candidate should attend counselling & on the spot admissions on their own as per the schedule **notified at the website**. The candidate should bring along with them proof of having appeared for the computer center based entrance test such as Admit Card or photo copy of application form / Demand Draft etc.

The candidate will be offered a seat in the institute of their choice and programe as per the combined merit list prepared by Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Pune for all the institutes and all the programmes. #### Mode of Payment of Fees shall be as given below

The fee is to be paid either through online mode or Bank Draft of any Nationalized bank drawn in the name of "The Principal, School of Audiology & Speech Language Pathology, BVDU, Pune". payable at Pune". The details of payment through online mode will be informed.

At the time of admission a candidate has to pay library deposit. This deposit shall be refunded upon completion of the programme.

If a candidate fails to confirm admission given to him/her, the same shall stand cancelled and the resultant vacancy will be offered to the next eligible candidate from the computer centre based Entrance Test Merit list. However, if candidate is unable to report in person, he /she can depute a representative with an authority letter signed by the candidate (Annexure I appended in this brochure) along with requisite documents under sec.7.2 above and Demand Draft of fees.

There are a few seats available in the hostel which will be allotted on first come first served basis.

Those who are desirous of getting admission to the hostel will be required to pay the entire amount of rent for the year as well as the mess charges for the entire academic year at the time of admission only. The details of hostel fees will be given in counselling letter. The payment for the hostels should be made by separate Demand Draft.

The date and commencement of the programme and detailed time table will be communicated to the candidate by the respective Institute.

#### REFUND OF FEES:

The cancellation of admission and refund of fees will be as per the UGC guidelines issued by UGC from time to time.

#### 10. CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE:

If any student is found indulging in anti-national activities, or in activities that run contrary to the letter and spirit of the provisions of Acts and Laws enforced by the Government, or any activity that causes his/her behavior to be contrary to rules of discipline, will be liable to be expelled from the institute forthwith without any notice by the Principal of the institute.

If any of the statements made in application form or any information supplied by the candidate in connection with his/her admission is, at any time, found to be false or incorrect and willful suppression of facts, his/her admission will be cancelled forth with. The fees will be forfeited and he/she may be expelled from the institute by the Principal and prosecuted, if deemed necessary.

- 11.3 The Institution shall have the right to satisfy about the conduct and character of a candidate by verifying antecedents of a candidate through the appropriate police-authority, before admitting him/her to the institute.
- 11.4 The Attention of the candidates is particularly invited to the provisions of rules regarding the eligibility of candidates for admission to the MSc. (Audiology) 2023 & MSc. (Speech Language Pathology) 2023 Programme. If at any stage it is found that a candidate is not eligible either for admission to MSc. (Audiology) 2023 & MSc. (Speech Language Pathology) 2023 Programme, his/her candidature and admission even if granted provisionally will be cancelled forthwith.
- 11.5 Differences of opinion and disputes arising in the interpretation and implementation of the clauses in this Brochure, if any, will be referred to the Vice-Chancellor of the Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Pune and his decision shall be final and binding on all the concerned.

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
